## Call for innovative projects in the field of nutrition and metabolism School of Life Sciences / EPFL

Funding through the current call will encourage individual projects that involve EPFL scientists, or collaborations between EPFL scientists and researchers elsewhere in the world. This call will also favor collaborative projects that cross boundaries between nutrition/metabolism and engineering or medicine, or projects that develop or apply a systems approach to the study of nutrition and metabolism. In order to strengthen the scientific community actively performing research on this important topic, another aim is also to attract scientists from other fields towards nutrition/metabolism-related questions. We also expect that projects funded through the Kristian Gerhard Jebsen Program will have the potential to continue through other funding beyond the current program's timeframe.
> 1 to 5 successful proposals will be funded depending on the quality of the proposals.
> Duration of the projects: 2 years
